

INSTITUTIONAL EFFECTIVENESS

BUFFALO STATE COUNTS

In 2016–2017, 1,443 students participated in community–engaged learning through 96 courses taught by 52 faculty members. Students provided over 492,000 hours of service which equates to \$13,500,000 to the community!

International students account for nearly 10% of Buffalo State's residential students.



In 2017, Buffalo State students participated in 837 internships.



18,048 cups of coffee were sold at SPoT for the fall 2017 semester.

In 2016, 17 faculty members from a wide range of disciplines were selected to participate in the Fulbright Program.

An average of 1,888 meals are served per day in the Bengal Kitchen.

Nationally, 48% of students that borrow student loans don't realize they have borrowed.



Events management signed and confirmed 1,600 student events held on campus in 2016–2017.

In 2016–17, 1304 petitions were filed. Late registration adjustments comprised the majority (n=686 or 53%) of the petition requests – with the top three late registration adjustment request being late drops (n=337 or 26%), late adds (n=197 or 15%), and late withdrawals (n=152 or 12%).

Nearly 20% of residential students have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

The University Police Department responded to over 14,000 calls, conducted over 3,700 community oriented policing foot patrols, conducted 85 educational programs, and over 1,700 premise checks of campus academic and administrative buildings in 2017.



The Alumni Association averages 63 alumni events, with just over 2,600 participants per year.



University Police and University Police Student Assistants (UPSAs) conducted 275 motorist assists in 2017.
